

# Parents are Forever

## Who Must Attend:

By local rule of The Franklin County Court of Common Pleas, Division of Domestic Relations, all parents with minor children who are parties to a divorce, dissolution, or legal separation action must attend within 45 days of filing.

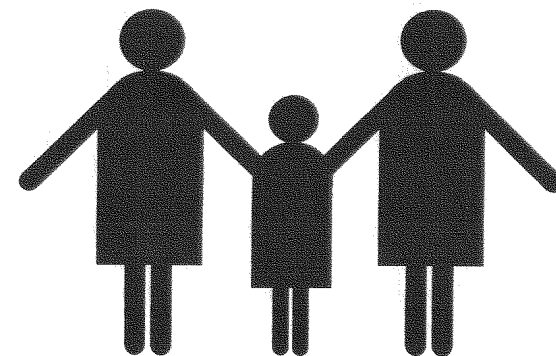
## How to Register:

Pre-registration is required. Parents who have not pre-registered will not be admitted. Call the seminar registration line of **Children's Hospital Guidance Centers** at 794-2447 and you will be asked to give the following information on a recorded message:

- **Name** as it appears on legal papers. Please spell your name.
- **Court case number.**
- **Phone number.**
- Choice of seminar **date and time.**
- Whether you would prefer to attend at a **different time than your child's other parent.**
- Parents whose cases are filed **outside of Franklin County** need to pay **\$10** at the seminar. When calling to pre-register indicate that the case is filed outside of Franklin County.
- Each parent must call **separately to pre-register.**

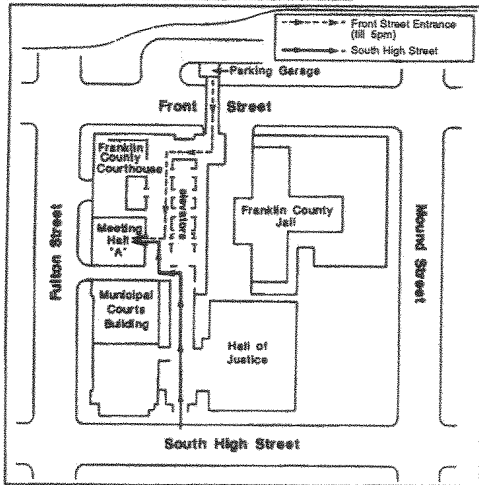
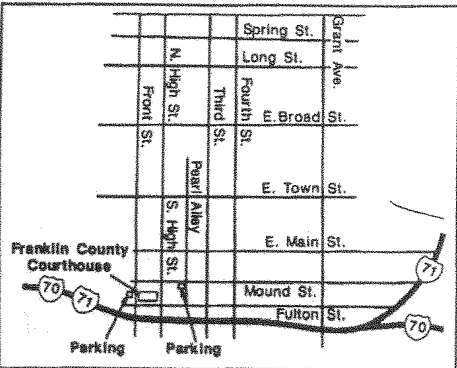
## At The Seminar:

- **Arrive 15 minutes** early to sign in and receive materials.
- **Bring Court Case Number** to seminar.
- **DO NOT BRING CHILDREN** to the seminar. Child care is not provided.
- **Certificates** will be given to parents who complete the entire program. The program will notify the court of your attendance.
- Parents attending **evening sessions** must **sign in with Security** at the Information Desk in the front lobby of the Courthouse.
